I was unable to attribute one of the coins you sent for attribution. I feel it may be an unlisted variety that should be inspected by Leroy Van Allen for possible new listing. I would describe it to him as follows:

1881-O. Reverse is the same as VAM 1I, with multiple clashes visible at top edge of wing. First 8 doubled right inside lower loop rather disinctly. No obverse clashes, so obverse die was swapped out.

If you do send this coin to Leroy for attribution, you can retum it to me with a copy of his description and this letter I will label it at no charge other than retum shipping. For instructions for sending Leroy coins, refer to this page on V .
